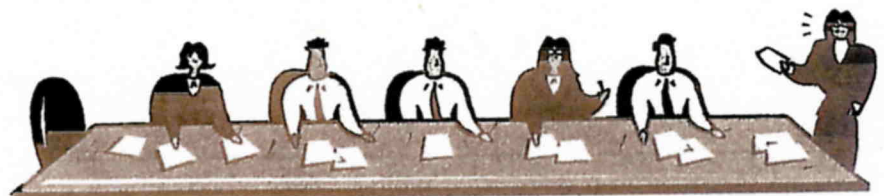

# **Information from Serra Convention**

*FROM OUR DELEGATE: RICHARD SIEGEL*

1. \$4.00 increase in Serra International dues approved by voice vote
2. Serra International Long Range Planning Committee Report
  - All published motions to regarding report were withdrawn
  - Several former SI presidents recommended delaying implementation
  - Letter from Justin Cardinal Rigali cautioned against hasty implementation
  - Delegates recommended to new SI board a 2.5 year delay regarding any organizational changes.
  - Further, in the interim, an ad hoc committee made up of all interested and impacted parties, including bishops, representatives of Bishop's councils, and outside experts would review present and proposed structures and make recommendations as to what, if any, changes would be most effective for Serra in the 21st Century.
  - Additionally, it was recommended that both SI and USAC By-laws be reviewed and completely updated.
3. New officers for USAC and SI were presented and approved
4. Banner club banners were awarded to the Broward County and South Palm Beach County clubs (2 of 31 clubs to receive this award). The Indian River Area Club was awarded the Padre Club banner (1 of only 13 clubs to receive this award).
5. A new handbook for Vocation Activity is available from USAC. This first edition contains every known vocations activity currently being used by a Serra Club in the USA. All clubs are requested to review this handbook and submit any activity you know of that is being used by a Serra club anywhere in the world for consideration and inclusion in the next printing.
6. More detailed information will be available shortly at both the SI and USAC websites and in upcoming publications.
